

BRAMBLE - £8.00

Created in 1908's London by Dick Bradsell, this classic spring cocktail is favorite amongst the world of cocktails. Berries and lemon on top of a gin and berry base create this treat, named after the blackberry bushes, that are also called brambles.

PORNSTAR MARTINI - £8.00

The Pornstar Martini is one of the UK's most famous cocktail exports. Our version is based upon the owner's night in London with the creator himself, Douglas Ankrah.

PINA COLADA - £8.00

The earliest known story states that in the 19th century, Puerto Rican pirate Roberto Cofresí, to boost his crew's morale, gave them a beverage or cocktail that contained coconut, pineapple, and white rum. This was what would be later known as the famous piña colada.



APEROL SPRITZ - €7.50

Lengthened with prosecco and soda, this Aperol-based cocktail is commonly served in northern Italy. This aperitif is refreshing and flavorsome until the last drop.

OLD FASHIONED - €8.50

The Old Fashioned is an old, established cocktail originally known as ‘the whiskey cocktail’. Sweetened with sugars and aromatized with bitters, the old fashioned has been around in many variations since around 1880.

COSMOPOLITAN - €8.00

The Cosmopolitan, a stylish pink concoction in a coupe glass, was the signature cocktail in the 1990s for Carrie Bradshaw and her “Sex and the City” friends.



MOJITO - £8.00

When pirates invaded Cuba, the drink was introduced to Pirate Drake where he promptly used rum in place of the Cuban moonshine. The drink took on the name El Draque, until it became the Mojito. Also available in a:

STRAWBERRY DAIQUIRI - £8.00

Believed to have been created by an American engineer who visited 'Daiquiri' after the Spanish-American war in 1898, he negotiated a ration of rum for him and his fellow miners, later experimenting with ingredients to invent what we are used to today.

FRENCH 75 - £8.50

In French, it is simply 'Soixante Quinze'. The drink dates to World War I, and an early form was created in 1915 at the New York Bar in Paris, later at Harry's New York Bar. Made with Gin, Limoncello, Lemon Juice And Sweetener & topped with Prosecco



PEACH BELLINI - €7.50

Made famous by Harry's Bar in Venice, it is named such because of its unique pink colour with similarities to the toga of a saint, in a painting, painted in the 15th Century by Artist Giovanni Bellini. Made with Peach Liqueur, Peach Syrup & Prosecco.

CAIPIRINHA - €7.50

The Caipirinha was invented by landowning farmers in the region of Piracicaba, interior of the State of São Paulo during the 19th century as a local drink for 'high standard' events and parties, a reflection of the strong sugarcane culture in the region. Made with Cachaca, Lime & Sugar.
